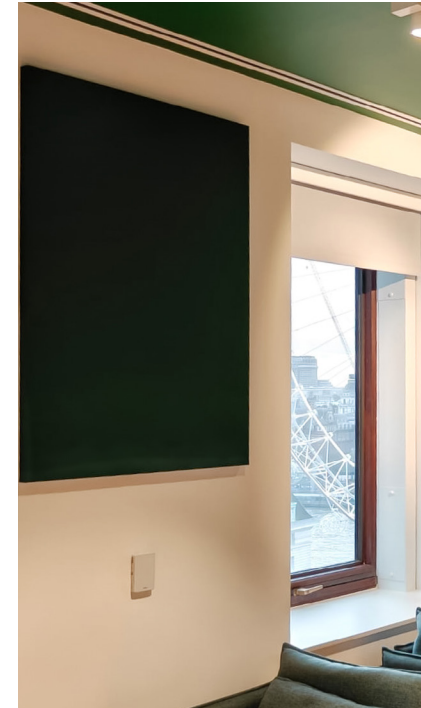

Overview

Stagsden Village Hall is a beautifully restored 19th-century building that serves as a vital hub for the local community, hosting various activities and events. A standout feature of the hall is its stunning vaulted ceiling. While visually striking, the combination of the vaulted ceiling and hardwood floors created an acoustic challenge, leading to excessive echo and poor sound quality.

Our solution

To resolve the acoustic issues in Stagsden Village Hall, Resonics installed **Ecophon Solo** Rectangle acoustic ceiling panels. This solution was selected for its ability to deliver:

Class A Sound Absorption: Exceptional noise reduction to tackle reverberation and echo effectively.

Aesthetic Appeal: Panels blend seamlessly with the architecture, preserving the hall's aesthetic.

Durability: Ensures long-term effectiveness in a frequently used space.

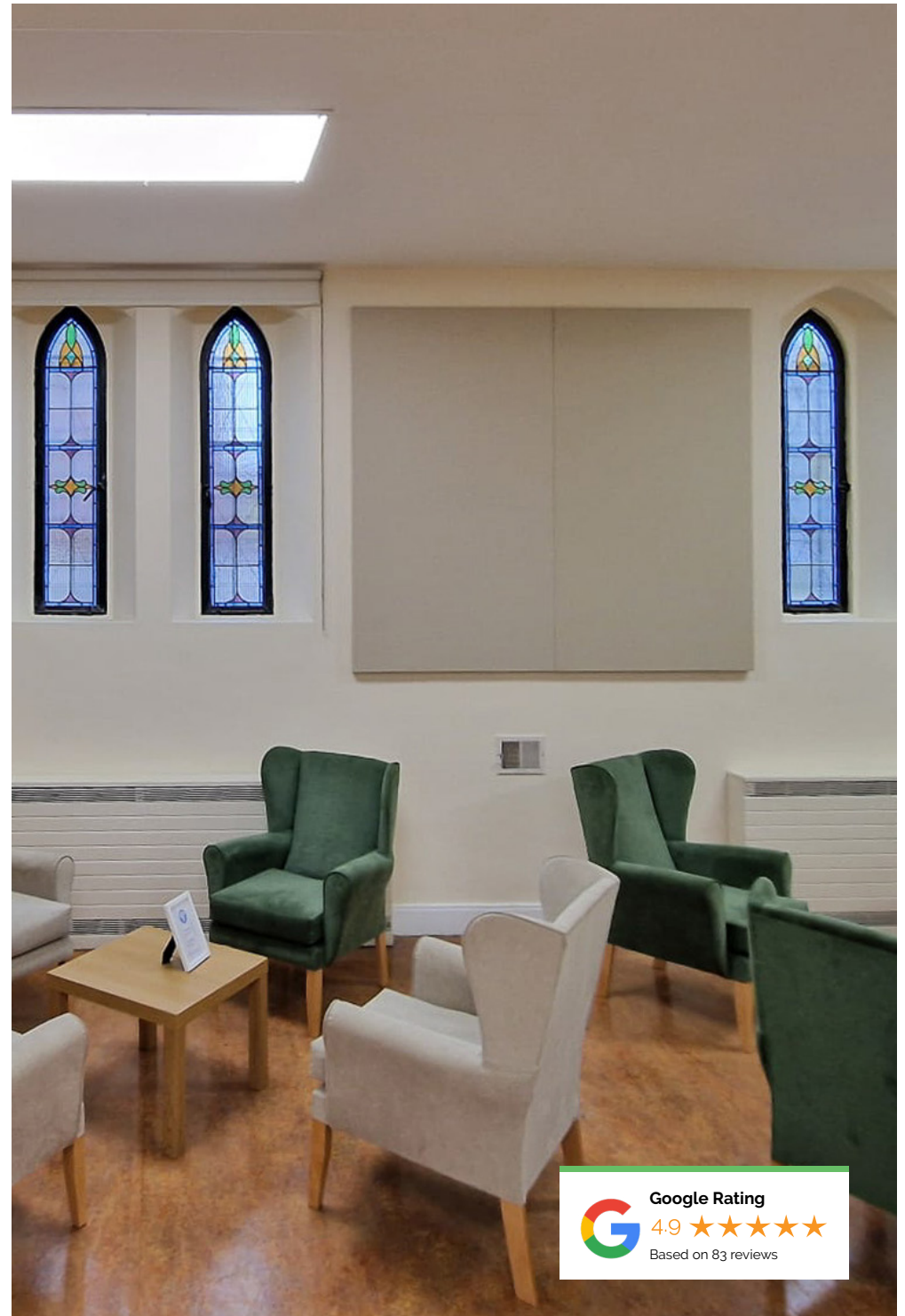
